Emerging in the '90s with fresh snarl and energy, they earned critical acclaim and audience devotion. Magic Dirt has experienced new waves of success, unleashing their pure rock energy to audiences

Nashville-based, South Carolina-born Nikki Lane possesses a timeless wickedly captivating voice. Her earnest, heartfelt songwriting and live energy has built a devoted following. Collaborations with Josh Homme's on 2022's Denim & Diamonds help to subvert country music expectations, establishing Lane as an intriguing, impactful songwriter.

Twin brothers Jack and Pat Pierce form one of Australia's most dynamic performance duos, entertaining audiences domestically and abroad for over a decade. Their undeniable chemistry combines strong songwriting with a boundary-pushing approach to folk-rock. The duo have enjoyed extensive sold out runs in Australia, Europe, UK and South Africa.

NSW South Coast favourites The Vanns have enjoyed a prolific rise with two strong albums, Through The Walls and Last Of Your King. The indie group quickly became Triple J darlings, with an impressive touring schedule and millions of streams. Their storytelling and powerful live performances have coined them a much-loved act.



Singer-songwriter Grace Cummings possesses one of music's most commanding and powerful voices. The enigmatic live performer draws influence from Townes Van Zandt, Lucinda Williams, and Bob Dylan. Her magnetically rich, emotionally intelligent music culminated in 2024's standout album Ramona, nominated for the Australian Music Prize.




